

After this period, degeneracy and decay of the Toltec race set in. The connection with the Occult Hierarchy was broken. The attainment of wealth and authority and the ruin of enemies became the objects towards which their occult powers were directed. They turned their occult powers from there lawful use, and practiced them in the use of black sorcery. No longer submitting to the wise rule of the Initiate emperors, the followers of the black arts rose in rebellion and set up a rival emperor who drove out the White Emperor from the City of the Golden Gates and put himself on the throne. The White Emperor, driven northward, re-established himself in a city now the seat of the tributary Toltec kings, who welcomed him. These events took place 50,000 years before the first great Calamity, where millions perished. The City of the Golden Gates was now a den of iniquity. The City's inhabitants were destroyed, and the continent decimated. Eventually, a Semite dynasty of sorcerers enthroned itself in the City of the Golden Gates, but no Toltec power rose to prominence during the second map period. On the Island of Ruta in the third map period, a Toltec dynasty rose to power that was addicted to the black arts, which became more prominent during the four map periods. The author then mentions the strange social experiment of the Turanian race, who being bested in wars by the Toltecs, passed laws by which every man was relieved from the burden of maintaining his family, having the State provide for the children. It increased the birth rate, but destroyed ties of family life and marriage. The scheme being a failure; was given up. The Semites, a marauding and energetic race, bent towards a patriarchal form of government and developed a considerable empire in the second map period. In the third map period, the Akkadians finally overthrew the Semite people. They were traders and sailors, and mimicked ancient Sparta with a duel system of two kings reigning in one city.


Emigrations are discussed next with the various root races branching out to all points on the earth. The Rmoahals went to the Greenland cape and the western shores of the Scandinavian Island. The Tlavatli people spread out to every point of the compass: California, Rio de Janeiro, and India where they mixed with the indigenous Lemurian population and formed the Dravidian race. The Toltecs emigrated to the North and South American Continents where they established the empires of Mexico and Peru. The first settlement of Egypt is from the Toltecs when the transfer took place 400,000 years ago from the White Lodge of initiates. This Occult lodge founded an empire: the first Divine Dynasty of Egypt and the two great Pyramids of Egypt. The Semites spread west to the lands of America and east to Europe, Africa and Asia. The first great Aryan kingdom was established in the southern shores of the Central Asian sea area. The Akkadians spread eastwards, occupying the Levant and reaching as far as Persia and Arabia, and peopled Egypt.

Stonehenge was founded in the early Akkadian days, 100,000 years ago by the colony of initiates as a protest in the simplicity of the rocks in contrast to the extravagant over-decoration of the existing temples of Atlantis. Other chapters deal with Architecture where buildings were massive structures. Education included every man knowing magnetic healing, chemistry, mathematics and astronomy. Agriculture which dealt with the crosses between wheat and wild grass gave oats and cereals and the banana. Air Ships were used as private yachts and in war replaced the ships at sea. Writing material consisted of thin sheets of metal. Weapons included poison gas bombs. Leather or metal tokens were used as money like promissory notes. Religion was taught by Adepts who recognized a Supreme Being whose symbol was the sun. Great monoliths were built on hilltops.

The book includes two maps of Atlantis at its prime from the world about 1 million years ago to the catastrophe of 800,000 years ago along with Atlantis in its decadence after this catastrophe to the one about 200,000 years ago. It is a fascinating study of an Ancient civilization that resonates in all ages. The next report will deal with the continent of Lemuria.

From the Lamp of Knowledge

Legends of Atlantis and Lost Lemuria

Based on the Clairvoyant Invesitgations of C.W. Leadbeater

Atlantis and Lemuria are the fabled Lost Continents described in this book. Whereas the story of Atlantis has existed for 2500 years, Lemuria was not hypothesized until around 1850, and was started as a Scientific Hypotheses.

In the Story of Atlantis, the legend comes from Plato's dialogs, The Timaeus and the Critias. The Timaeus follows another dialog, the Republic. Critias ultimate source is Solon, the great lawgiver who heard this from the Egyptian priests. It is about a war fought in primeval times between Athens and a mighty sea power known as Atlantis. Located by the Pillars of Hercules, it was settled by ten sons of Poseidon, the eldest being Atlas, from whom Atlantis was named. At first, the country was a rich and peaceful land, ruled by a divine dynasty. But over time the people deteriorated to a greedy, warlike one. They were defeated in their bid to conquer Europe and Asia by ancient Athens. After military defeat, earthquakes andfloods sank the Island in a single day alleged to be 11,500 years ago.

Platos's students disagreed how to interpret the story. The four main views are the historical, allegorical, parabolical and mythical. In the first, Plato is believed to be recording actual history, which is not reconcilable with present day scientific knowledge. A modern view is that Plato was talking about the Minoan Crete Empire, which was destroyed by a volcano 900 years before his time. In allegory, Plato was actually creating an allegory about the political machinations and ideals of his own time, and how he thought Athens as an ideal state should function. He saw the dangers on the horizon, and felt that the physical destruction of Atlantis foretold the political destruction of Athens. In myth, which may be founded by historical fact, its importance is far greater than historical record. The story of Atlantis has become subliminally reverberated throughout the ages to all generations.

The author's investigations begin with the various root and sub races, the 5th or Ayran race composing the present day, with the 6th and 7th to follow.. The Rmoahal is the first that came into existence between 4 and 5 million years ago, at which large portions of Lemuria still existed. They had a height of 10-12 feet, a dark race. The eventually migrated to the south shores of Atlantis, and some of them reached Iceland. The Tlavatli Race were a mountain loving people. They started off an Island off the West Coast of Atlantis and spread into Atlantis proper. The Toltec, or 3rd sub-race ruled Atlantis for thousands of years. Their remote family races ruled as well in Mexico and Peru. The Turanian Race were colonists from the earliest days.

Scott-Elliot gives as evidence for the existence of Atlantis in 5 classes:

- 1. The testimony of deep-sea surroundings
- 2. The distribution of fauna and flora
- 3. The similarity of language and ethnological type
- 4. The similarity of religious belief, ritual and architecture
- 5. The Testimony of ancient writers and of archaic flood legends

It was the Toltec race who developed the highest civilization and organized the most powerful empire of any of the Atlantean societies, and it was then that the principal of heredity succession was for the first time established. The Toltecs were first divided into a number of independent kingdoms, at war with each other, and all at war with the Rmoahals of the south. These tribes were eventually reduced to slavery. Around one million years ago, these separate kingdoms united in a great federation with an Emperor at its head. This was inaugurated by great wars, but prosperity and peace was the eventual outcome, and a Golden age was maintained for 100,000 years.

I believe we should be celebrating our own personal accomplishment as a Lodge and as California Masons for having elected our first African American Worshipful Master at Culver City-Foshay Lodge, No. 467. Why do I say we should see that as a momentous occasion? It is simply due to the history of the whole lot of race relations in the United States, in California, in the City of Culver City and even in our Lodge. Our Lodge building was erected in 1928, seven years after the Free Masons of California were successful in pioneering the expulsion of the KKK from the fraternity in this state! Yet, Culver City itself remained a "sundown town" for decades after that. Not until the mid '80s did the dark shadow from the remnants of that history begin to dissipate as a whole in Culver City. Many of the old quard in the city's law enforcement community were still enforcing an unwritten code of "ethnic discretion" that was not consistent with the changing times. Most of that has since changed and even the department itself has, for the most part, discarded those practices. Our Lodge is right alongside their advancements, as is the City of Culver City. Making good man better is our deepest sentiment and, from the top all the way down, we as California Free Masons are exercising this in such a way that am I personally proud to be a Brother of the Fraternity as a whole!

To Kenneth L. Burges whom we affectionately call "Kast" – Congratulations! To our Lodge Brothers of our lodge who were the first to open the doors to people of Color – Thank you sincerely for exercising the best parts of our humanity. And to all our brothers today, from Grand lodge to our lodge, – We all salute you!
